POLICY

Academic Placement is required of all new students unless exempt by a waiver. The academic placement tests help assess students' skills and identifies which course or courses best suit the student's academic skill level. Students may qualify for a placement test waiver using one of multiple measures determined by the College (e.g., high school GPA and ACT or SAT scores) which are found in the College Catalog.

Students who qualify may work with an admissions representative, academic advisor, or the Registrar's Office to obtain the waiver.

Students who qualify for a waiver in either Math or Writing, but not both, will need to complete the placement test assessment for the skill area not exempted.

Students must present all appropriate documentation when requesting a waiver.
