Families may receive assistance twelve times during a twelve-month period. Provides emergency food for three days for individuals in need. The work of the Food Bank is supported by contributions of food and money from individuals, religious congregations, organizations and businesses. The Food Bank is owned, operated, and staffed by volunteers.
