FOOD ASSISTANCE IN CAMBRIA COUNTY

SNAP (Food Stamps)

What is it? The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly Food Stamps is the largest and most important source for helping people feed their families.

Who runs it? Local County Assistance Office.

What does it provide? Participants receive a monthly allotment on an Electronic Benefits Transfer card (EBT), similar to a bank machine card, that can be used to buy food at any store that accepts food stamps.

Do I qualify? Eligibility depends on several factors, including income guidelines that change yearly. If you have applied for Food Stamp Benefits in the past and were ineligible, you may be eligible under the updated guidelines. You can get Food Stamps even if you don't get cash assistance.

Senior Box Program (CSFP)

A federally funded nutrition program to provide a monthly distribution to elderly persons at least 60 years of age who meet income eligibility requirements at 130% of the poverty line: \$1,784/month for a family of 2 or \$1,315/month for an individual. Service is limited and there may be a waiting list. For further information, contact Food For Families: 814-535-3315. This Institution is an Equal Opportunity Provider.

Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)

What is it? WIC provides nutritious foods for eligible Women, Infants, and Children

What does it provide? Participants receive vouchers for nutritious foods including fruits, vegetables, milk, eggs, peanut butter, cheese, juice, cereal, infant formula and baby food. Additional vouchers for fresh produce in summer and fall are also provided.

Do I qualify? WIC is available to eligible pregnant women, nursing, and bottle-feeding mothers, and infants and children up to the age of 5 years in families with incomes up to 185% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines. Expected babies are counted in family size.
